Results July 2017

This is the second year of the Key Stage 1 and 2 tests which were used to assess children against the new national expected standard of achievement. These tests were the second to reflect a more challenging primary curriculum which was introduced in 2014. The cohort of children who were tested at the end of Key Stage 2 in May have been hard as they faced higher national expectations after just three years of this new curriculum, rather than the usual four years of Key Stage 2. Therefore it is only possible to compare results to one previous years.

Below are tables showing how our school Key Stage 1 and 2 results compared to the national figures in 2017.
